Gross Domestic Product Semi-annual (January – June) 2003

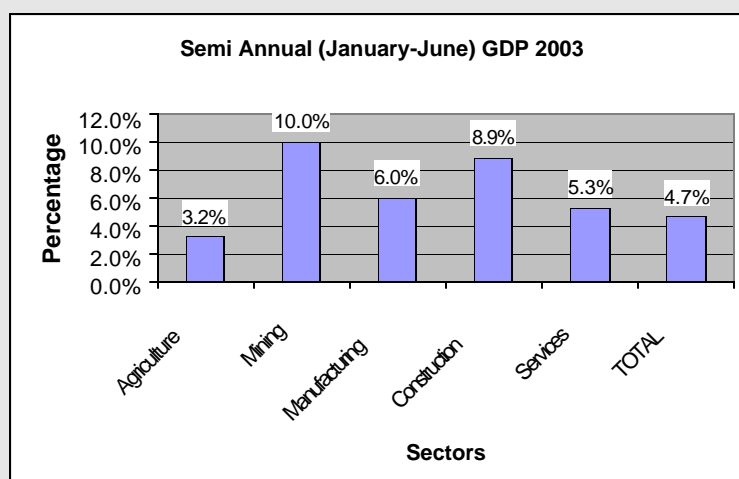
Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices increased by 4.7% in the Semi-annual (January – June) 2003, compared with the corresponding period 2002.

The fastest growing sector were mining at 10%, construction 8.9% and manufacturing 6.0%.

These sectors accounted for only 15% of total GDP for the said period.

Services sector increased by 5.3%. While the agriculture sector, with the largest share 45%, contribution to the economy grew by 3.2%.

In 2002/03, GDP stood at Tshs 4,527 billion, 11% higher than in 2002.

GDP is measured at factor cost. (In Tanzania valuation at factor cost is insignificantly different from basic prices.) FISIM (Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured) has been distributed to the sectors Value Added. The published figures for January – June 2003 are provisional.
